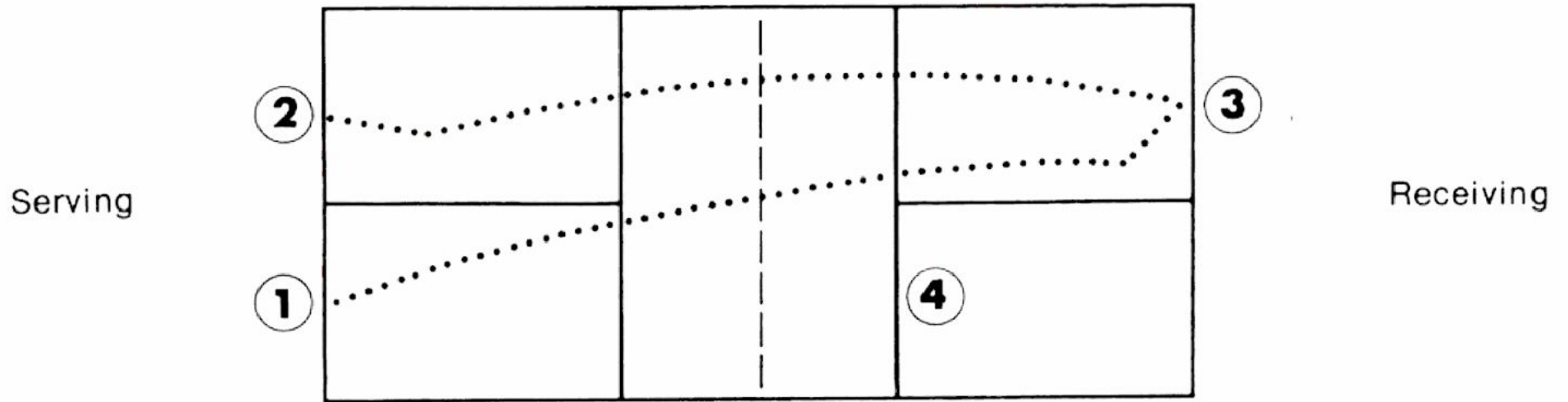


Double Bounce Rule

Each team must play their first shot off of the bounce.

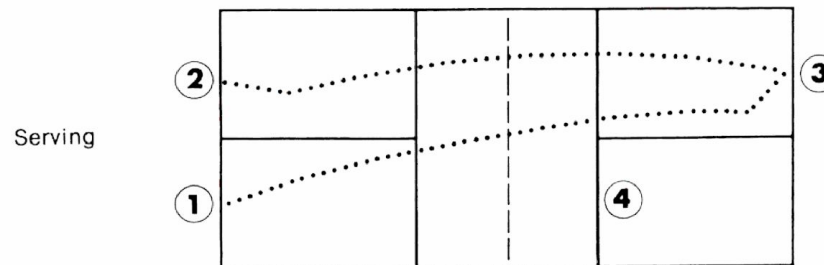
The receiving team must let the serve bounce and the serving team must let the return of the serve bounce before playing it. Once these two bounces have

occurred the ball can be either volleyed or played off the



bounce.

3 Unique Attributes of Pickleball



Receiving



1. Serve Position

2. Double Bounce Rule

3. No Volley Zone

Faults

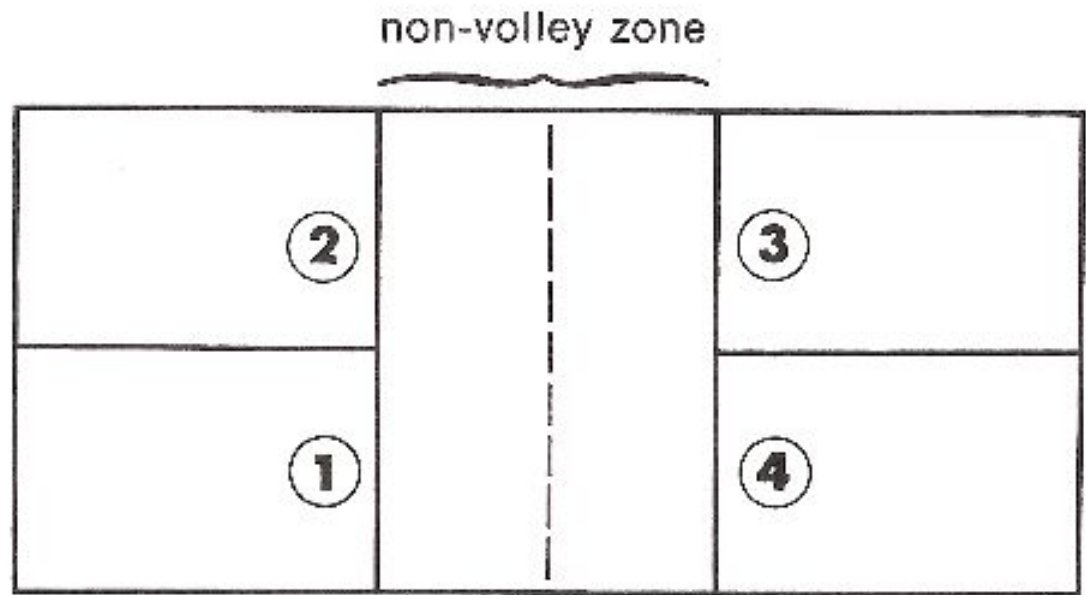
- Serving the ball into an incorrect area
- Hitting the ball out of bounds
- Volleying before the Double Bounce Rule

- Hitting the ball into the net
- Hitting the ball while in the No Volley Zone

No Volley Zone

- **You MAY NOT hit the ball in the air while standing in the no- volley zone of the court.**
- **You MAY step into the zone to play the ball on a bounce.**

Position of players at net when volleying



- You **CANNOT** step into the zone before the ball hits the ground.
